Implementation of PhilHealth Claim Forms 1,2 and 3

RELATIVE to PhilHealth Circular No. 11, s-2000, hospitals are encouraged to familiarize themselves with the use of the May 2000 revised Claim Forms 1,2 and 3.

For hospitals using computer-generated forms, the small boxes (bars or fences) may be deleted provided that the data entries follow the same order or arrangement of the revised forms. Hospitals manually accomplishing these claim forms should comply with the prescribed forms.

In order to give more time for hospitals to adjust their computer systems' program to the forms and/or consume existing forms, the mandatory use of the revised forms is suspended until September 30, 2000. Claims for patients admitted starting October 1, not written in the new forms and submitted to this office and its branches nationwide will be denied.
