SUBJECT	;	New Design of PhilHealth Number Card

Effective May 2010, the new PhilHealth Number Card (PNC) shall be issued to members in the Individually Paying Program (IPP) and Employed Sector (private and government). The said card serves as proof of membership registration in the NHIP and shall indicate the member's Permanent Identification Number (PIN), complete name and signature.

The new ID card (Annex A) has the following features:


- The PhilHealth logo is placed at the left top corner of the card, above the box provided for the member's 1 ¹/₂" x 1 ¹/₂" photo.
- A magnified PhilHealth logo with yellow and green fine prints is set as background in watermark design.


The previously issued PNCs shall still be honored as proof of membership registration in the NHIP, however, members are hereby reminded to update their member record as PhilHealth gears towards adopting the unified multi-purpose identification system compliant ID (UMID), which shall be released at a later date.
