n a groundbreaking move, the recent signing of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between PhilHealth NCR and Rizal and Electron **College of Technical Education represents** a watershed moment in expanding access to crucial primary care services. This marks the first-ever collaboration between PhilHealth NCR and an educational institution in implementing the PhilHealth Konsultasyong Sulit at Tama or PhilHealth Konsulta. The MoU ensures that all faculty members and students of Electron College and its sister educational institutions will now have access to primary care services covered by the PhilHealth Konsulta program.

The initiative reflects a commitment to provide primary care services to as many members possible. PhilHealth NCR strives to bridge the gap in accessibility through such collaboration, helping ensure that people from all walks of life from the less fortunate to the working class—can benefit from these services. Leading this historic first collaboration were Dr. Bernadette C. Lico, Vice President of PhilHealth NCR and Rizal, and Dr. Lea Galicia Solis, Owner and CEO of Electron College of Technical Education. Their shared mission and dedication to improving healthcare access opened the ground for this monumental agreement.

On December 14, 2023, the MoU was formally signed at the Office of the Vice President for PRO NCR and Rizal in Quezon City. This strategic partnership is poised to have a positive impact by ensuring that healthcare services are easily accessible to the educational community of Electron College of Technical Education, setting a precedent for potential future collaborations between PhilHealth and other educational institutions. ###
