- 2.5 Upon successful delivery and installation of all Four (4) Network LaserJet Printers, PHIC shall saue an Inspection and Acceptance Report and shall be used for payment purposes. The said Acceptance will be the onset contract for the three (3) years of the warranty period for Four (4) Network LaserJet Printers.

3. Technical Assistance

- 3.1 The proponent should be able to provide a team of technical and dedicated personnel that will be tasked with the installation and maintenance of the project.
- 3.2 During the period of the project, the proponent's team should successfully provide technical maintenance and support.

4. Warranty and After Sales Support

- 4.1 All Network LaserJet Printer delivered shall have at least three years warranty. These shall be free from defects due to design and workmanship.
- 4.2 For the after sales support, in cases of any of the following units had malfunctioned, the said unit shall be reported/ coordinated to the proponents.

Terms Of Reference: I.T Equipment (4 units Network Laserlet Printers)

- Should IT equipment within the warranty period must undergo repair, the cost for labor, parts and courier (pull-out for repair and on-site delivery upon repair) shall be charged against the 4.3 winning proponent.
- In cases where the unit must be repaired more than 24 hours, the proponent must provide a service unit with similar or higher 4.4 specification.

5. Technology Transfer/ Training

Provide free of charge training to PHC technical personnel to be conducted by certified trainers at certified training centers.

6. Consumable Parts

Cost and availability of all consumable parts such as toners, 6.1 fuser film and others will be part in the evaluation process.
