Use of PIN/PEN Encouraged for Fast and Easy Transactions

To expedite transactions with PhilHealth, all members from the government and private sectors and their respective employers, as well as Individually Paying Members (IPMs) and Non-Paying Members (NPMs) should use their PhilHealth Identification Numbers or PINs.

Employers who have not obtained their PhilHealth Employer Numbers (PENs) yet are advised to register with any of PhilHealth's offices nationwide while employees who have not been issued their PINs must coordinate with their employers to facilitate the issuance of their PINs.

Retirees and pensioners from the government and private sectors who are now considered Non-Paying Members are encouraged to formally enlist with PhilHealth for the issuance of their ID cards.

Members who already have their respective PINs but continue to use incorrect numbers in transacting with PhilHealth are enjoined to coordinate with our PhilHealth Members' Assistance Center (PMAC) at 637-7680 and 637-6449 (NCR) and with any of our Regional and Service Offices nationwide to ask about their PINs/PENs.
