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PhilHealth offers one-week course for ICD-10 Coders

The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation through its training arm, the PhilHealth Training Institute (PTI) will be offering a one-week training course for ICD-10 Coders on August 3-7, 2009 at the Training Room, 10th floor Citystate Centre., 709 Shaw Blvd., Bgy. Oranbo, Pasig City.

Hospital personnel involved in the actual clinical coding of diseases and surgical procedures, as well as those who are involved in the documentation and recording of diagnoses and surgical procedures, are encouraged to undergo such training and gain expertise in the use of ICD-10 in view of the implementation of ICD-10 (International Classification of Diseases and Related Health Problems - 10th Revision).
