Certificate Course on ICD-10 Coding in Cebu and Davao


The **PhilHealth Training Institute (PTI)**, in cooperation with the **Health Finance Policy Sector (HFPS)** and the **Office of the Regional Vice-President of PhRO-VII and PhRO-XI** (PhilHealth Regional Offices VII and XI), is offering a five-day Certificate Course on ICD-10 Coding (International Classification of Diseases, Version 10) for coders. The training will be held on **October 26-30, 2009 in Cebu City** and **November 16-20, 2009 in Davao**.

The course is ideal for those involved in the actual clinical coding of diseases and surgical procedures (coders) and those who document and record diagnoses and surgical procedures (non-coders) who need to gain expertise in the use of ICD-10.

- How to code with ICD-10 – comprehensive lectures, chapter by chapter, manuals, and group exercises on actual diagnosis/charts
- Death Certificate and Fetal Death Certificate
- Translation of Coded Data into Statistics
- Common Errors in Coding
- Some Basic Diagnostic Requirements
- ICD-10 Philippine Modifications – ICD-10 Shortlist
- ICD-10 World Health Organization (WHO) 2006 Updates
- Background on the National Health Insurance and PhilHealth
