## CERTIFICATE COURSE OFFERINGS FOR CY 2010

The **PhilHealth Training Institute (PTI)**, training arm of the **Philippine Health Insurance Corporation**, offers the following courses for 2010:

### **I. Certificate Course on ICD-10 Coding (five days)**

With the full implementation of ICD-10 (International Classification of Diseases, 10<sup>th</sup> Revision), clinical coders and non-coders are expected to gain expertise in this protocol.

Through this course, participants learn the steps in using the World Health Organization's ICD-10 as a coding tool. The course covers 26 modules, including the definition of ICD10, benefits derived from its usage, history of its development, its elements and structures, the general guidelines for coding, and specific instructions for coding morbidity and mortality data.

This one-week course is ideal for those involved in the actual clinical coding of diseases and surgical procedures (coders) as well as those who document and record diagnoses and Surgical procedures (non-coders) who need to gain expertise in the use of ICD-10.

Offered monthly starting **February 22-26, 2010** at the PhilHealth Training Room, 10<sup>th</sup> floor Citystate Centre, 709 Shaw Blvd., Pasig City.

**Course fee:** P7,500.00 inclusive of training materials and meals.

### **II. Quality Assurance/Quality Improvement (QA/QI) for Patient Safety (two days)**

Intended for Administrators and Safety Officers of Lying-in clinics, Primary and Secondary hospitals, the course focuses on inexpensive measures to improve general health care services.

### **III. Course on Social Health Insurance as a Mechanism for Social Inclusion (five days with field trip)**

Helpful for lower to middle income government wanting to implement a social health insurance program that encompasses all sectors of society.
