PhilHealth Premium Payment Slip (PPPS) not accepted as official receipt

All accredited collecting agents (ACAs) are advised not to use the PhilHealth Premium Payment Slip or PPPS (*sample shown below*) as the official receipt of premium payments received from PhilHealth members.
