Mandatory Use of Electronic Premium Reporting System (EPRS) in the Preparation and Submission of Monthly Remittance Report (RF-1) and Phasing Out of Other Reporting Schemes

All employers from the government and private sectors are henceforth required to use the EPRS in preparing and submitting monthly remittance reports (RF-1). In this regard, other reporting schemes except for the PhilHealth Premium Remittance Scheme-Positive/Negative (PPRS-PN) will gradually be phased out. It is expected therefore, that before the end of year 2012, all RF-1 reports should be processed using the EPRS.

However, employers with ten (10) employees or less may submit their remittance report quarterly in hardcopy format.

This new policy shall be effective immediately hence, employers are hereby advised to contact or coordinate with the nearest PhilHealth office regarding the orientation, training and subsequent registration to the EPRS.
