


Manual of Procedures (MOP) of Provider Engagement through Accreditation and Contracting of Health Services (PEACHeS)

To ensure fast and efficient delivery of health care services to the members and dependents of the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP), the process of accrediting Health Care Institutions (HCIs) has been modified through PhilHealth Circular 54 s. 2012, entitled “*Provider Engagement through Accreditation and Contracting for Health Services*” and other related issuance. The MOP aims to:

1. Provide guidance for HCIs applying for Basic Participation
2. Describe the accreditation process for automatically and non-automatically accredited HCIs

The MOP shall cover the manual processing of applications for basic participation, including the process and requirements, and updating the profile of HCIs until such time that the new electronic system for accreditation shall be implemented. It may be downloaded from the PhilHealth website and printed for the use of health care institutions who wish to participate in the NHIP.


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
