

## **ONLINE PAYMENT AND REMITTANCE REPORTING NOW POSSIBLE WITH INTER-LINKAGE OF PHILHEALTH'S ELECTRONIC PREMIUM REMITTANCE SYSTEM (EPRS) AND LANDBANK'S ELECTRONIC MODIFIED DISBURSEMENT SYSTEM (eMDS)**

All National Government Agencies (NGAs) with existing Modified Disbursement System (MDS) Sub-Accounts with Land Bank of the Philippines shall now pay their premium contributions and submit remittance reports online via the inter-linkage solutions of the EPRS and LANDBANK eMDS.

The EPRS is a web-based application that we provide to all employers in the private and government sectors to manage their membership, remittance and reporting functions online. The eMDS, on the other hand, is a secured internet banking facility developed by LANDBANK for its NGA clients. It allows them to do selected MDS transactions online.

With the PhilHealth EPRS-LANDBANK eMDS facility in place, payment and reporting of PhilHealth premium contributions are made more convenient through three (3) easy steps that can be done anywhere and anytime within the due date:

- a. Update employees' remittance status;
- b. Generate Statement of Premium Account (SPA); and
- c. Select LANDBANK (as preferred online payment bank) to transmit the SPA and to request approval to credit the amount stated in the SPA to PhilHealth via the eMDS facility.

Successful transactions will be issued with respective electronic PhilHealth Acknowledgement Receipt (ePAR) within the day which will be readily viewable in their EPRS account. Immediately thereafter, their EPRS remittance report (eRF1) will be automatically posted to the employees' individual contributions accounts in PhilHealth.

With this solution, NGAs need not endure traffic and falling in line to pay over-the-counter and to submit their List of Due and Demandable Accounts Payable (LDDAP) documents to PhilHealth in order to get their official receipts. They also need not submit remittance report lists (RF1) to manually post payments to the individual accounts of their employees.

To avail of this service, employer representatives may visit any of our Local Health Insurance Offices (LHIOs) to have an EPRS account, and visit any LANDBANK branch to enroll in the eMDS facility.
