

## SUSPENSION OF FILING OF THE APPEAL / MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION FOR PCB1 PAYMENTS WITH REPORTS FILED BEYOND THE 60 DAYS REQUIREMENT DUE TO PROVIDERS' TRANSITION TO ELECTRONIC FILING OF PCB1 REPORTS

As per PhilHealth Circular No. 015, s-2014, Item No. IX, Section 3, it states that:


*“only PCB1 provider reports that are submitted within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this issuance shall be processed. PFP for reports submitted beyond this deadline shall be forfeited. The PCB 1 providers, however, **may file an appeal** for payment of PFP to the PROs.”*

In due consideration of the PCB providers to acquire information technology resources and establish connectivity and / or partner with an Electronic Medical Record (EMR) service providers, please be advised that submission of motion for reconsideration or appeal as a requirement for late PCB reports shall be suspended.

This advisory shall take effect covering PCB reports for 2016 and 2017.
