


REGISTRATION OF BANK ACCOUNTS FOR THE MANDATORY IMPLEMENTATION OF AUTO CREDIT PAYMENT SCHEME (ACPS)

Pursuant to PhilHealth Circular 2017-0020 on the nationwide implementation of ACPS, all accredited Health Care Institutions (HCIs) are required to be ACPS compliant for purposes of claims reimbursements.

All accredited HCIs should be guided by the following:

- a. Submission of requirements for bank account registration in ACPS shall be extended up to **November 29, 2017**;
- b. HCIs currently implementing ACPS are still required to submit requirements and register their bank accounts for the additional information detailed in PC 2017-0020;
- c. All accredited HCIs should be ACPS-compliant by November 29, 2017. Reimbursement shall be put on hold and checks shall not be issued to HCIs that do not comply with the ACPS requirements.
