Please be advised that PhilHealth is expanding its Primary Care Benefit (ePCB) to all members and their qualified dependents under the formal economy (employed), lifetime members and senior citizens.

In line with this, we are calling on all concerned providers with the capacity to provide the following essential services under the ePCB to submit their application for accreditation beginning August 1, 2018.

- Health screening and assessment/consultation
- Essential services (CBC, Urinalysis, Fecalysis, Lipid Profile, ECG, FBS, OGTT, Chest X-ray, Sputum Microscopy and Paps smear/VIA)
- Medicines (Amoxicillin, Co-amoxiclav, Co-trimoxazole, Erythromycin,
 Ofloxacin, Amlodipine, Enalapril, Metoprolol, Hydrochlorothiazide+Losartan,
 Simvastatin, Metformin, Gliclazide, Salbutamol Inhaler, Salbutamol Oral,
 Fluticasone-Salmeterol Inhaler, Prednisone, Paracetamol and ORS)
