

Urgent Request for Hospital Data on Available Mechanical Ventilators and Status of Isolation Beds

In the light of the raising of Code Alert System for the COVID-19 from Code Red Sublevel 1 to Code Red Sublevel 2, the National COVID-19 Emergency Operations Center is now studying the capacity of hospitals in the country to cater to COVID-19 patients.

As such, we request all accredited health care institutions (HCIs) to submit their **daily status update** on the following using the prescribed format:

A. Isolation beds

Total number of isolation beds	Number of occupied beds	Number of available beds

B. Number of available mechanical ventilators (these may be used for severe cases of COVID-19 who are eligible for ICU admission but will be admitted in isolation)


Total number of mechanical ventilators	Number of ventilators currently in use	Number of available ventilators

To hasten and streamline the reporting process, a mobile application has been developed. Accounts to access information shall be provided to reporting hospitals through their respective DOH-Center of Health Development or CHDs. All hospitals are expected to update the requested data before 8:00 am daily using the mobile application to be monitored by CHDs via the webpage tracker.





Guide on using the DOH Data Collect (DDC) Mobile Application for BED TRACKING

STEP 1 Download the DDC Mobile Application (BED TRACKER) using this link: ddc.doh.gov.ph/bedtracker.apk
Install the mobile application (For Android-based mobile phones only)
Log-in using the credentials emailed to you by FICT or your respective CHD





STEP 2 Verify if the name in the application is correct Click (+) plus button to start adding report

Start encoding in the required fields

Click submit to send data
