





## Payment Deadlines of PhilHealth Contributions

To help relieve the financial hardship currently being experienced by many Filipinos during this coronavirus pandemic crisis, self-earning individuals, professional practitioners, and members of group enrolment schemes shall be allowed to pay for their premium contributions for the 1st semester (January-June 2020) until June 30, 2020.

For the Employed Sector, all unpaid contributions for the applicable months of February, March and April shall be acknowledged without interest until June 22, 2020 in line with the Bayanihan to Heal as One Act. Employers implementing a skeletal workforce arrangement are reminded to ensure that employees with no earnings or income are properly reported using the RF-1 or eRF-1 generated through the EPRS. Employers who have temporarily stopped operations should immediately submit an electronic copy of a properly accomplished ER-3 to their respective Accounts Officer. The submission of the ER-3 is also required for Employers who have resumed operations.
