





## Amendment to the Minimum Length of Stay (LOS) in PhilHealth Accredited Community Isolation Units (CIU)

With the issuance of DM 2020-0439 (Omnibus Interim Guidelines on Prevention, Detection, Isolation, Treatment, and Reintegration Strategies for COVID-19) and as provided in PhilHealth Circular 2020-0018 (Guidelines on the COVID-19 Community Isolation Benefit Package Rev 1, Section V-B2) to wit:

"Any further changes to the applicable DOH guidelines shall immediately take precedence and shall serve as the basis for reimbursement."

Please be advised that the Annex E of PhilHealth Circular 2020-0018 is revised as reflected below (*italicized font*):

Mandatory Service	Other Services (as needed)
a. Minimum 10 days admission, inclusive of boarding, food, and individual hygiene kit*	A. Drugs and Medicines, as specified in the applicable
<ul><li>b. Information and Education about respiratory etiquette and self-monitoring</li><li>c. Monitoring by a Health Care Professional</li></ul>	DOH policies  B. Diagnostic Tests and Imaging, as specified in the applicable DOH policies
*Except in case of transfer due to deterioration or mortality and applicable guidelines adopted by DOH.	C. Oxygen support D. Referral and transportation to higher level facility
