



Validity Extension of DOH License-To-Operate (LTO) Expiring on December 31, 2023

Per the Health Facilities and Services Regulatory Bureau of the Department of Health (DOH), the validity of the issued DOH LTOs set to expire on December 31, 2023 are extended until January 15, 2024. Hence, all accredited health facilities (HFs) with no DOH LTOs yet for 2024 are encouraged to submit their applications for renewal on or before the deadline of the prescribed filing period¹ provided that their DOH Official Receipts are submitted in lieu of the LTO.

HFs that submitted beyond the prescribed filing period due to late issuance of LTO may appeal for the removal of gap in accreditation, as cited in PhilHealth Circular No. 2023-0012.
