





Installation and Maintenance of PhilHealth Signages in all Accredited Health Facilities

All accredited health facilities (HFs) are enjoined to install and regularly maintain their respective PhilHealth signages. This is in line with the general objectives of Republic Act No. 11223, or the Universal Health Care (UHC) Act. In part, the UHC Act aims to "ensure that all Filipinos are guaranteed equitable **access** to quality and affordable health care goods and services, and protected against financial risk."

The signages will assist PhilHealth members to easily recognize accredited HFs where they can avail of their benefits. Hence, the signages has to be maintained to ensure that it is always in good condition, adequately illuminated at night, visible, appropriate, and at par with the specifications set by the Corporation in PhilHealth Circular No. 0013, s. 2009.

PhilHealth will monitor the compliance of its partner-HFs on this policy.
