





TO: ALL ACCREDITED KONSULTA PROVIDERS USING MYPHILHEALTH PORTAL

Clarification on the Konsulta Registration Module

All accredited Konsulta Package Providers (KPPs) using MyPhilHealth Portal must declare their maximum patient load upon renewal of their accreditation for each calendar year, e.g. CY 2024.

Please be informed that the registration module will be enhanced to reflect the total number of registered beneficiaries which will be higher than the declared patient load of the KPP. This enhancement will allow registration of additional beneficiaries beyond their declared patient load but this will not affect the performance of the KPP because the denominator for computing the Konsulta Statement Account Payable 2 (SAP2) is registered beneficiaries with validated First Patient Encounter (FPE).

The registration of a beneficiary to a preferred KPP will proceed following these conditions:

- 1. The beneficiary is a member/dependent of National Health Insurance Program (NHIP) or with existing PhilHealth Identification Number (PIN).
- 2. The beneficiary is not yet registered in another KPP.

Furthermore, all KPPs need to fulfill the prerequisites for accreditation. Kindly refer to the list of requirements in PhilHealth Advisory No. 2023-0037. For KPPs with records not found in the registration module, they are advised to coordinate with the PROs to update/renew their accreditation.
