

## Call for Applications for PhilHealth Accreditation as an Ambulance Service Provider

All licensed Ambulance Service Providers (ASPs) are encouraged to apply for PhilHealth accreditation. Accredited health facilities with ambulances may also submit an application for re-accreditation for additional service.

Per PhilHealth Circular No. 2025-0022, interested ASPs shall submit the following to the nearest PhilHealth Local Health Insurance Office:

1. Fully-accomplished Provider Data Record<sup>1</sup>.
2. Notarized Performance Commitment duly signed by the Head of the Facility<sup>2</sup>.
3. Copy of the updated DOH License to Operate (LTO) for ASPs, or its equivalent for health facilities with ambulances as part of their licensing requirements.
4. For ASPs with PhilHealth-accredited physicians: Professional Regulatory Commission (PRC) License and Advanced Life Support (ALS) certificates or proof of training of the physician/s.
5. Proof of payment of accreditation fee (P1000.00 for standalone ASPs and the existing accreditation fee for facility-based ASPs).
