SUBJECT : Entitlement of Indigent Members to Unified Medicare Benefits

DATE : July 25, 2000

IN line with the recent unification of Medicare benefits under the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP), please be reminded that qualified members and their dependents enrolled through the Indigent Program of the NHIP are entitled to the same Medicare benefits as other NHIP members under other membership categories.

As such, under the Warranties of Accreditation, all accredited health care providers are reminded to render services to these indigent members who are given indigent identification cards as shown below:
