SUBJECT

Uniform Computation of Poverty Threshold

I. RATIONALE

The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) recognizes the need to have a uniform interpretation of poverty as measured by poverty threshold and per capita income. These are the main variables used in the identification of target members to the "Medicare para 54 Masa" Program.

II. DEFINITION OF TERMS

- A. Household refers to a unit composed of an enrolled member and his legal dependents.
- B. Poverty threshold is the annual per capita income required or the amount to be spent to satisfy nutritional requirements (2Kcal) and other basic needs such as clothing and footwear; fuel, light and water; rental or occupied dwelling units; medical care; education; transportation and communications; non-durable furnishings; household operations and personal care and effects.
- C. Urban Areas refer to all cities regardless of their population density and to municipalities with a population density of at least five hundred (500) persons per square kilometer. This include all barangay(s) or portion(s) of which comprising the poblacion and/or the Central Business District (CBD) and the built-up area including the urbanizable land in and adjacent to the CBD; and where at least more than fifty percent (50%) of the population are engaged in non-agricultural activities. 2/
- D. Rural Areas are defined as "areas outside of the poblacion and/or CBD and where more than fifty percent (50%) of the population are engaged in agricultural activities.³

- E. Poor families/individuals are those whose income fall below the poverty threshold.
- F. Poverty incidence is the proportion of families/population whose annual per capita income falls below the annual per capita poverty threshold to the total number of families/population in a given area.
- G. Indigent refers to a person who has no visible means of income, or whose income is insufficient for the subsistence of his family, as identified by the Local Health Insurance Office and based on specific criteria set by the Corporation in accordance with the guiding principles set forth in Article 1 of the National Health Insurance Act of 1995(RA 7875).

III. COMPUTATION

A. Sample Case:

Given: Family A from Luna, La Union has seven (7) members, three (3) members are working with the following income:

Father = \$\mathbf{P}\$5,000/cropping; 3 croppings/year

Daughter A = \$\mathbf{P}\$1,500 per month

Son A = \$\mathbf{P}\$3,000 per month

B. Computation of Annual Per Capita Income:

Annual Per Capita
Income of Family A

= Total Annual Family Income
No. of Family Members

= P69,000.00

= P9.857.14

C. Based on Table 1 and Annex A, Luna, La Union is a 4th class urban municipality in Region I with a Poverty Threshold Income of P12,755

D. Interpretation:

If the Annual Per Capita Income of a family is less than or equal to the Annual Per Capita Poverty Threshold Income of the region where the household is located, then the family is considered poor or indigent.

In the above case, the Annual Per Capita Income (\$\mathbb{P}9,857.14) of Family A is evidently lower than the Region I Per Capita Poverty Threshold for urban areas (\$\mathbb{P}12,755.00). Therefore, Family A is considered indigent and qualified to become a beneficiary of "Medicare para sa Masa" Program.
