SUBJECT :	Implementing Guidelines for ICD-10 System and Incorporation of the Philippine Modification into the ICD-10 Coding System

This is to reiterate the implementation of PhilHealth Circular No.34, s-2001, (*Implementation of the ICD-10 and Introduction of New Case Type Classification*), which took effect on July 1, 2002 pursuant to DOH Administrative Order No. 47, s-2000.

The following implementing guidelines for ICD-10 systems shall be implemented starting January 15, 2003 admissions.

- All claims with no codes shall de denied and shall be non-appealable.
- All claims with incorrect codes within the first three (3) characters shall similarly be denied.

This is in line with PhilHealth's adherence to the use of complete and correct coding system to facilitate proper and expeditious processing of claims.

All concerned are advised to comply with the attached guidelines (Annex A).

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## Implementing Guidelines for ICD-10 System:

- 1. All claims with no codes **shall be denied** and **shall be non-appealable** pursuant to Philhealth Circular No. 34 s.2001.
- 2. All claims with incorrect codes within the first 3 (three) characters **shall similarly be denied** effective January 15, 2003 admissions.

\*This is to reiterate Philhealth's adherence to complete and correct coding system to facilitate proper and expeditious processing of claims. Particularly, characters affixed at the end of the code (such as laterality codes and behavior codes in neoplasm) is exceptionally significant in proper evaluation of these claims.

Correspondingly, to provide a proper coding system to accommodate diagnostic terms existing in the Philippines, the following coding modifications are incorporated to the ICD-10 system.

Eurthermore, to specify laterality (left, right, bilateral, unspecified) involving cataract, ICD-10 Cataract code should be affixed with laterality codes as follows:

- 0 Left
- 1 Right

2-Bilateral/Both

9 – Unspecified site

### Example. Senile Cataract

We must also reiterate that to facilitate processing and to avoid denial of claims concerning neoplasm, please include the site, morphology and behavior codes.

Example 1. Acute myelomonocytic leukemia ~ C92.5 M9867/3
Example 2. Polycythemia vera – D45 M9950/1
Example 3. Metastatic carcinoma of brain – C79.3 M8010/6

Philhealth, in consultation with the Department of Health and World Health Organization, may modify the coding system to reflect existing disease conditions as deemed appropriate.

All other issuances consistent with this Circular shall remain in full force and effect. Please be guided accordingly.
