Issuance of New Accreditation ID Cards with the New

Accreditation Number Convention

In line with the thrust of the Corporation to enhance PhilHealth benefits for accredited professionals, PhilHealth will be issuing a new accreditation ID card which reflects the new accreditation number convention. The new number convention is designed to accommodate modifications and enhancements, for future benefit packages which is presently being developed by the Corporation. The new coding scheme will also accommodate the preferential payment for quality services that PhilHealth deemed provided by qualified professional providers. Further, the said new number convention is composed of twelve (12) numerical characters, to be used in all PhilHealth transactions starting January 1, 2006.

The first four (4) numbers shall be interpreted as stated in "ANNEX A".

The new accreditation ID cards will be released to professionals once every three (3) years after initial accreditation, re-accreditation, upgrading of accreditation and during the renewal of accreditation. A physician who applies for upgrading of accreditation while his/her accreditation is still active has to submit all documentary requirements and should pay the accreditation fee of P1, 500. A new ID card will be released to the concerned physician, and the validity of his/her accreditation is three (3) years from the date of issuance.

The information reflected in the accreditation ID card shall be as follows:

Renewal of Accreditation	Valid for three (3) years - from the birthdate up to the day before the birthdate, 3 years after	The applicant must apply on the first month of the four months before the expiration of accreditation.



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In case of damage or loss of accreditation ID card, the concerned professional can request for replacement of the same from the PhilHealth Regional Office, PhilHealth Service Office or Central Office, Accreditation Department. The requirements are as follows:

- 1. Affidavit of loss, as the case may be
- 2. 1x1 ID pictures (2 pcs.)
- 3. One hundred and fifty pesos (Php 150.00) replacement fee

\* In case the field of specialization is not reflected in the 3<sup>rd</sup> column, please coordinate with PhilHealth for clarification.

The first column reflects the Professional Type whether physician, dentist or midwife. The 2<sup>nd</sup> column (Claims Code Group) reflects the fee for service payment scheme applicable to the physicians. The 3<sup>rd</sup> column (Sub-classification Coding) reflects the specialty and subspecialty recognized by the Philippine Medical Association as well as other societies that PhilHealth deemed to provide quality care. This will be the basis of the new benefit payment scheme being developed by the Corporation.

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Likewise, the Claims Code Group five (5) are further sub-classified into three (3) based on the physician's completed hospital training. This will also be used as reference for the new payment scheme when the claims system is fully functional. The records of physicians can be changed as requested by the one concerned, provided that the required documents (such as residency training certificates issued locally and/or abroad, DOH specialty certification, or certification issued by the Specialty Societies, etc.) are submitted. No additional fee shall be required. Physicians who opted not to request for sub-classification shall be retained at Claims Group one (1) with sub-classification code "00".
