SUBJECT	:	Amendments to PhilHealth Circular 10, s. 2012 re: Universal Health Care Primary Care Benefit 1 (PCB1) Package for Transition Period 2012-2013

PhilHealth Circular No. 10, s. 2012, entitled "Universal Health Care Primary Care Benefit Package for Transition Period 2012-2013" requires the submission of periodic reports by the Primary Care Benefit (PCB) providers as basis of the Corporation in the computation and release of the Per Family Payment Rate (PFPR). The following are the amendments/clarifications to facilitate the submission of reports and computation of the PFPR:

- 1. Within fifteen (15) working days of the months of October 2012, January 2013, April 2013, July 2013, October 2013, and January 2014, the following documents must be submitted:
 - a. Masterlist of Enlisted members for PCB1
 - b. Annex A.2: (PCB Clientele Health Profile)
 - c. Annex A.4: (Quarterly Summary of PCB Services Provided)
- 2. The PFPR shall be released by the PhilHealth Regional Office through the Local Health Insurance Office within thirty (30) working days upon receipt of complete reports from the PCB provider.
- The PFPR of OPB/PCB providers with assigned Sponsored Program members (identified through NHTS and re-enrolled by LGUs) for the 1st and 2nd quarters of 2012 may be paid if the following conditions are met:
 - a. PhilHealth Regional Office certifies that the health facility actually provided the primary health services to the Sponsored Program members during the aforementioned quarters.
 - b. The OPB/PCB provider has submitted its Performance Commitment to the PhilHealth Regional Office on or before June 30, 2012.

All other existing issuances inconsistent with this Circular are hereby repealed, modified, and/or amended accordingly.

This Circular shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in any newspaper of general circulation and shall be deposited thereafter with the National Administrative Register at the University of the Philippines Law Center.
