SUBJECT : CLARIFICATIONS AND AMENDMENT TO PHILHEALTH CIRC 10 S. 2012 "IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR UNIVERSAL HEALTH CARE PRIMARY CARE BENEFIT I (PCB1) PACKAGE FOR TRANSITION PERIOD 2012-2013" RE: CLARIFICATION OF DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF REPORTS AND AMENDMENT TO THE P100 FOR CY2012

To provide sufficient time for the profiling of the members and their dependents, computation of the Per Family Payment Rate (PFPR) for the 3rd tranche will be based on the number of Primary Care Benefit 1 (PCB1) entitled members who have **enlisted during the quarter**. Further, the PFPR of members for all applicable quarters of CY 2012 who were enlisted after September 30, 2012 will be included in the computation of the PFPR for the 4th tranche.

To facilitate the implementation of Primary Care Benefit 2 (PCB2), PhilHealth Circular 10, s.2012 is hereby amended to reflect that the computation of the PFPR for the 4th tranche will be based on the number of PCB1 entitled members who are enlisted and the number of PCB1 enlisted members and dependents who are profiled. This is reflected in the Primary Care Benefit 1 Manual of Procedure for Providers

In recognition of the effort of our PCB1 providers who have done early profiling, the P100 PFPR incentive for the CY 2012 is amended such that it shall be released to PCB1 providers who were able to complete their profiling by the end of the 3rd quarter. A softcopy of PCB1 Annex A.2 report can be downloaded from www.philhealth.gov.ph/downloads. The Annex A.2 shall be submitted using the prescribed spreadsheet to the official email of their Local Health Insurance Office on or before October 15, 2012.

Computation for the release of the **P100 PFPR for 2012** shall be as follows:

$$\frac{\# \text{ of enlisted members and dependents who were profiled}}{\# \text{ of enlisted members and dependents}} \times P100 \times \# \text{ of enlisted members} = (P100)PFPR$$

The disposition and allocation for the P100 incentive will be as follows:

1. A minimum of fifty percent (50%) shall be exclusively used for honoraria of the staff directly involved in PCB1 activities.
2. A maximum of fifty percent (50%) of the PFPR shall be used for operational costs.

All other provisions of previous issuances which are inconsistent with this Circular are hereby repealed, modified and/or amended accordingly.
