# ANNEX 2 – LIST OF PROCEDURE CASE RATES (REVISION 3.0) AND SUPPLEMENTARY GUIDELINES FOR ALL CASE RATES

#### 1. What is Annex 2 Revision 3.0?

Annex 2 Revision 3.0 shall now be used as reference for procedure case rates. It covers selected procedures with changes in case rates amounts that are listed in Annex 2 – List of Procedure Case Rates (Revision 2.0). Also, included are amended provisions stated in PC No. 12 - 2015, selected supplementary guidelines for ACR.

### 2. What procedures are affected by these changes?

Selected ophthalmic and dermatologic procedures. Further, accredited specialist trained in EENT are now allowed to reimburse ophthalmic surgical and laser procedures.

#### 3. What are the new requirements concerning Intraocular Lens (IOL)?

The Food and Drug Administration Philippines - registered intraocular lens (IOL) sticker or box shall be attached to Claim Form 2 for claiming cataract procedures.

In transition, the IOL sticker or box should be labeled with but not limited to:

- 1) product or brand name;
- 2) model or reference code;
- 3) manufacturer; and serial number until August 31, 2016 (1 out of 3 labels should be present and serial number).

Thereafter, all three (3) labels and serial number should be present. Otherwise, the claim shall be denied.

# 4. What is new in Cataract Pre-surgery Authorization (CPSA)?

CPSA shall no longer be required in cases of childhood and secondary cataracts. The clinical abstract or completely and properly filled out CF 3 (page 1) shall be attached to CF 2 otherwise, the claim shall be returned to sender.

#### 5. When is the effectivity of the Circular?

The new provisions of this Circular shall take effect for claims with admission dates starting July 1, 2016 unless otherwise specified.
