Revised PhilHealth Premium Payment Slip (PPPS)

1. What is PPPS?

The PhilHealth Premium Payment Slip or PPPS is a non-accountable payment form designed by PhilHealth to be filled out by payors/members paying premium contributions to PhilHealth Accredited Collecting Agents or ACAs. This form can be reproduced.

2. Why was the PPPS revised?

The PPPS was revised to exclude the employers from the Private and Government Sectors since they are mandated to register and utilize the Electronic Premium Remittance System (EPRS) for the generation of the Statement of Premium Account (SPA) effective August 1, 2016. It was also revised to specify other members who can pay premium contributions to PhilHealth ACAs.

3. Who are authorized to use the revised PPPS?

Payors/members with the following membership categories/types shall use the revised PPPS when paying premium contributions to ACAs:

- Informal Sector
- Self-Earning Individual
- Migrant Worker (OFW)
- Organized Group
- Household Help/Kasambahay
- Sponsored

4. When shall the revised PPPS be used?

The revised PPPS shall replace all remaining stocks of PPPS and shall be used immediately.

5. Where to get/secure the revised PPPS?

The revised PPPS can be downloaded from the PhilHealth website or may be requested from PhilHealth by the ACAs so that these are available in their counters for payors/members.
