PhilHealth Circular No. 2017-0018

Accreditation of Medical Detoxification Package Providers

1. Is there an accreditation fee required to become an accredited MDP Provider?

None.

2. When is the start of the validity of accreditation for MDP Providers?

- For accredited hospitals (Levels 1, 2 and 3), the accreditation shall be effective on the date the Letter of Intent (LOI) was received by PhilHealth.
- For free-standing government DOH licensed/certified Drug Abuse Treatment and Rehabilitation Centers (DATRC), the effectivity shall be on the date of complete submission of documentary requirements.

3. How long is the validity of the accreditation?

- For initial accreditation as a MDP provider, the validity is less than one year. The accreditation shall be effective on the date of submission of complete application and ends on Dec. 31 of the same year, except when the accreditation is terminated by the Corporation.
- For continuous accreditation, the start date is January 1 of the applicable year, if the institution submits the documents during the prescribed period, and ends on December 31.

4. When is the renewal period? What are the requirements to be submitted?

- To ensure continuous participation, the accredited HCI shall submit the completely accomplished Provider Data Record (PDR) and signed Performance Commitment from January 1 to 31 of the applicable year.
