PhilHealth Circular No. 2018-0015

Guidelines on the Use of Electronic Collection Reporting System (ECRS) (Revision 1)

1. What is ECRS?

The Electronic Collection Reporting System (ECRS) is a web-based application system that allows the Accredited Collecting Agents (ACA) to upload daily the RF2 in textfile format.

2. Who shall use the ECRS?

All ACAs with over-the-counter collection scheme.

3. What are the requirements in ECRS?

The ACA shall:

- a. Submit the completed and signed copies of the Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA);
- b. Submit the completed and signed PhilHealth Online Access Form (POAF);
- c. Copy of the company ID of their nominated user/s; and
- d. Attend the Orientation on the Use of ECRS.

4. Who shall sign the NDA?

The Executive Officer of the ACA or its authorized signatories shall sign the NDA.

5. What shall the user do prior to log-in or access to ECRS?

The user shall clear the cache of the web browser and make sure that no other application is running to avoid division of bandwidth among applications.

6. What shall the user do upon logged-in to ECRS for the first time?

The user shall change the default password provided by PhilHealth immediately upon logged-in to ECRS.

7. Is there a limitation in the number of users?

There is no limitation on the number of user. The ACA can nominate more than one (1) user and shall provide individual POAF for every user.
