Being one of the lead implementer of Universal Health Care in the country, PhilHealth has participated and presented its programs and mandates under the UHC Law, the benefits that members can avail of, and its COVID-19 response during an online forum entitled **“A good job for Philippine health care”** organized by The Manila Times (TMT) on Tuesday, February 22, 2022.

In her presentation, PhilHealth Vice President for Corporate Affairs and Spokesperson Dr. Shirley B. Domingo



(upper left) emphasized that under the UHC, all Filipinos are automatic members and are granted with immediate eligibility to the benefits, and that everyone shall be assigned to a primary care provider through the PhilHealth Konsulta program. She also pointed out some lessons that the country should learn from this pandemic such as the importance of strong public and private partnerships, the need to strengthen connectivity within the healthcare system, and the importance of healthy lifestyle as a disease prevention measure, among others.
