"ANNEX B"

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1. Suppliers/Providers shall provide correct and accurate information required in this form.
- 2. Suppliers/Providers shall quote on the project.
- 3. Price quotation/s must be valid for **thirty (30) calendar days** from the date of submission.
- 4. Price quotation/s, to be denominated in Philippine Peso shall include all taxes, duties and/or levies payable.
- 5. Quotation exceeding the Approved Budget for the Contract of the item shall be rejected.
- 6. Award of contract shall be made to the lowest quotation (for goods and infrastructure), passed the technical evaluation or, the highest rated offer (for consulting services) which complies with the minimum technical specifications and other terms and conditions stated herein.
- 7. Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by you or any of your duly authorized representative/s.
- 8. The item/s shall be delivered according to the requirements specified in the Technical Specifications and the official address of the corporation.
- 9. PhilHealth shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the goods to confirm their conformity to the technical specifications.
- 10. In case two (2) or more suppliers are determined to have submitted the Lowest Calculated Quotation/Lowest Calculated and Responsive Quotation, PhilHealth shall adopt and employ "draw lots" as the tie-breaking method to finally determine the single winning provider in accordance with the GPPB Circular 06-2005.
- 11. Payment shall be made via check (Land Bank) after delivery and upon the submission of the required supporting documents, inspection and acceptance.
- 12. Liquidated damages equivalent to one-tenth of one percent (0.1%) of the value of the goods not delivered within the prescribed delivery period shall be imposed per day of delay. PhilHealth shall rescind the contract once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount, without prejudice to the other courses of action and remedies open to it.
- 13. Warranty Security of one percent (1%) of the gross amount (for items with warranty) shall be automatically deducted from the contract for a minimum warranty period of three (3) months for expendable goods or one (1) year warranty for non-expendable goods and shall be returned after the lapse of the warranty period provided however that the goods delivered are free from defects and all the conditions imposed under the contract have been fully met.
- 14. The contracting parties shall comply with Office Order No. 0018-2015 "Reiteration of PhilHealth No Gift Policy (Revision 1).
- 15. Each of the documents submitted in satisfaction of the requirements is an authentic copy of the original, complete, and all statements and information provided therein are true and correct.

"ANNEX C"

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR CATERING SERVICES

- I. PROGRAM TITLE: Procurement of Catering Services for the Conduct of Salamat Mabuhay Program (Compulsory Retirees) in the Head Office
- II. DATE OF CONDUCT: CY 2025

III. MEAL PROVIDER SPECIFICATIONS:

- 1. Must be able to provide meals that are served in buffet style (lunch and pm snack) for three (3) Salamat Mabuhay Program (50 pax/each).
- 2. Serve a variety of Menu:
 - a. Steamed rice, fresh fruit and drinks
 - b. Main course includes fish, meat (pork and chicken), shrimp and vegetables
 - c. Pasta and sandwich
 - d. No-pork for Muslims
- 3. Must be able to provide appropriate clean and well disinfected utensils (such as flatware, glasses, chinaware and table cloth with napkins/tissues.
- 4. The Provider shall guarantee the provision of at least two (2) qualified, trained, courteous and capable personnel who observe proper hygiene and shall be required to wear clean and appropriate uniform and identification (ID) card. Said personnel shall assist in the distribution of food to the participants.
- 5. The Provider shall assign a point person to coordinate with the HRD PMRR Team regarding the schedule of the Salamat Mabuhay Program.
- 6. Menu proposals will be evaluated by the HRD PMRR Team vis-à-vis the Technical Specifications.
- 7. For First-time Bidders endorsed by the Secretariat for the Bids and Awards Committee (SBAC) for evaluation, food shall be requested by the HRD PMRR Team to determine whether the meals to be served have passed the standards. The Provider shall obtain an overall rating of at least 90% based on the following criteria for selection:

Criteria Percentage:

Taste and Quality of Food	50%
Serving Size/ Balanced Menu	35%
Food Variety / Options	15%
TOTAL	100%

- 8. Cooking and washing are not allowed at the premises. In case the Provider needs electrical supply, they should bring their own extension cord at the venue.
- 9. Proper sanitation in accordance with law (under "Food Establishment" as stipulated in Presidential Decree No. 856) shall be observed at all times. The Provider shall guarantee that food is prepared in accordance with sanitation law and shall maintain safe and clean food, equipment and other facilities in the surrounding areas of the activity.
- The Provider shall ensure that safety precautions are observed, monitored and provided at all times.
- 11. The Provider shall manage wet and dry garbage properly and also place covered garbage disposal bins around the venue.
- 12. Any damage to any of the facilities and equipment of PhilHealth, directly or indirectly, caused by the external provider's personnel shall be charged to the account of the Provider.
- 13. The Provider shall remove all things brought to the venue immediately after the event. The Provider shall allow the PhilHealth security personnel to check, if warranted, the wares and equipment to be brought out of the venue premises.
- 14. For meal providers who have rendered service with HRD, they must have earned at least 90% Performance Rating to serve as basis for the next bidding process.
- 15. The Provider must agree with the sent-bill scheme and comply with all the requirements that will be needed by the Secretariat for the Bids and Awards Committee (SBAC) of PhilHealth and PhilHealth Comptrollership Department during the processing of the payee's voucher such as but not limited to, if applicable:
 - a. BIR Annual Tax Return
 - b. Latest Proof of PhilHealth Contribution
 - c. PhilGeps Registration
 - d. Sample of Official Receipt
 - e. SEC Certificate of Registration, Updated Mayor's/Business
 - f. Statement of Account/Billing Statement/Sales Invoice

IV. BUDGET SOURCE

The estimated budget for the procurement of catering service shall be chargeable to the Corporate Operating Budget (COB) of the Human Resource Department for CY 2025 subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

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V. GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- The Meal Provider shall be blacklisted from the roster of PhilHealth's provider in case any provision in the agreed contract and Technical Specifications are retracted or were not completely rendered. A recommendatory report to blacklist the provider shall be prepared by the HRD for approval of the PRAISE Committee and dissemination for the information of all offices and departments in PhilHealth.
- The Meal Provider shall undertake to comply with Officer Order No. 0018-2015 entitled "Reiteration of PhilHealth No Gift Policy (Revision 1)", which enforces that "No PhilHealth personnel shall solicit, demand, or accept, directly or indirectly, any gift from any person, group, association, or judicial entity, whether from the public or private sector at any time, on or off the work premises where such gift is given in the course of official duties or in connection with any transaction which may affect the functions of their office or influence the actions of directors or employees, or create the appearance of a conflict of interest."
- Delay or failure to comply with or breach of any of the terms and conditions of the contract with PhilHealth, if occasioned by or resulting from an act of God or public enemy, fire, explosion, earthquake, perils of the sea, flood, war declared or undeclared, civil war, revolution, civil commotion or other civil strife, riot, strikes, blockade, embargo, sanctions, epidemics, act of any Government or other Authority, compliance with Government orders, demands or regulations, or any circumstances of like or different nature beyond the reasonable control of the Party so failing, will not be deemed to be a breach of the agreement nor will it subject either Party to any liability to the other.

Should either Party be prevented from carrying out its contractual obligations as a result of a force majeure event, the Parties shall come to a mutually acceptable arrangement, as to the best date and time to deliver the expected service for both the meal provider and PhilHealth Training and Development Team, without liability for either Party.
